The People's Republic of China has received a Grant from the GEF (managed by the World Bank) towards the cost of the GEF Large City Congestion and Carbon Reduction Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services ("the Services") under the Project include:

Contract CCR/CP3-Chengdu: Chengdu City Congestion Reduction Policy and Measures. The **assignment** objectives are based on the study on traffic congestion reduction policies practiced in China and other countries, traffic congestion reduction measures and policies will be tailored for Chengdu, these measures and policies will be carried out over Chengdu urban area to achieve the aims to reduce the traffic congestion drastically. The implementation period: 24 months. The service is expected to start in early December of 2014. The estimated staff input is 37 person months.

The Chengdu Municipal Government now invites eligible consulting firms ("consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services, such as:

- Core business and years in business
- Qualifications in the field of the assignment
- Technical and managerial organization of the firm
- General qualifications and number of key staff
- Details of the Experience that closely related to the assignment of this project

The shortlisting criteria are:

1. Consultant shall have experience of more than 1 project in the area of **Congestion Reduction Policy and Measures** at city level;
2. Consultants who have international experience and relevant national experience working on similar assignment will be preferred;

The attention of interested consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrower, January 2011 ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality- and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
