Travel Information

NOTE: Train disruptions on 31 May 2023 in Portugal

A strike between 00:00 and 23:59 on 31 May 2023 means there will be major disruptions to rail traffic affecting all services, with possible impact on the days before and after the strike period, on 30 May and 1 June.

Flying to Portugal

The closest airport is Francisco Sá Carneiro International Airport in Oporto, located ~70 kms to the north of Aveiro. Portela International Airport in Lisbon is located ~250 km to the south of Aveiro.

From Oporto airport to Aveiro/Coimbra

The trip between the Oporto Airport and the railway station Porto-Campanhã, which has direct rail connections to Aveiro/Coimbra, can be done by taxi for around 20€ and takes around 30 minutes. You can also reach the Porto-Campanhã railway station by Metro, which has a terminal at the airport. The trips between the airport and the railway station take about 32 minutes.







The train journey to Aveiro (Coimbra) takes between 40 min and 1h15 (1h30 – 1h45), depending on the type of train used. There are regular trains to Aveiro from Oporto.

From Lisbon airport to Aveiro/Coimbra

If you are arriving at Lisbon Airport, the simplest way to get to Aveiro (Coimbra) is by train from Lisboa-Oriente railway station. To get to the train station, you can go by taxi, which takes about 10 min and costs around 10€, but you can use the Metro (Pink Line) to Lisboa-Oriente railway station.

The train journey to Aveiro (Coimbra) takes between 2h and 2h30 (1h40 – 2h), depending on the type of train used.

Getting to the venue

31st May

From Coimbra train station to CIM-Coimbra Region

Coimbra has 2 train stations: Coimbra and Coimbra-B. Intercity and Alfapendular trains arrive at Coimbra-B train station, while regional trains can arrive at both railway stations. Trains between Aveiro to Coimbra-B train stations take between 30min to 50min and cost between 5,25€ to 16€. From Coimbra train station, you can take public transport bus lines 10, 45, 7T, 44, 26, 41, 9, 10A (stop Rua do Brasil 2), or get a Taxi/Uber/Bolt. You can also take a ~25-min walk from Coimbra train station to CIM-Coimbra Region.

1st June

From Aveiro train station to University of Aveiro

Aveiro railway station is located about 20min walking distance or 5min taxi ride from the University of Aveiro Campus. To reach the University Campus, you can also use the bus (Green Line) which departs at regular intervals from outside the railway station.

TRAIN info: You can check train timetables and book your tickets through the CP Comboios website or in the ticket offices at the train stations.

BUS info: You can find some bus connecting Porto, Aveiro, Coimbra, Lisbon here.
